In the English language, the word Religion is used for religion. The meanings of which are the method of worship, belief and fear and obedience of supernatural powers. As the famous thinker Durkheim (Emile Durkheim: 1858-1917) explains religion, he writes that:

A religion is a unified system of beliefs and

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practices relative to sacred things.<sup>3</sup>

Religion is basically a very sacred concept as people believe themselves to be connected to supernatural forces because of this sacred concept. As Catherine L. Albanese (1940-) explains this concept, she writes:

Religion can be seen as a system of symbols by means of which people locate themselves in the world with reference to both ordinary and extraordinary powers, meanings and values.<sup>4</sup>

## **Islamic Concept of Religion:**

From the study of the Holy Qur'an, it is known that when Allah Almighty sent the first human being Hazrat Adam (peace be upon him) to this world, he provided his material needs along with his spiritual satisfaction, kept it in the worship of God, Lord of the worlds. Not only that man was a monotheist from very first day, but he was also a messenger calling for divine monotheism. All the prophets, peace be upon them, were sent to every nation to teach people the straight path and pure monotheism. Allah Alimighty says in Quran:

As Imam Fakhruddin Razi (1736-1795) writes in his commentary on this verse:

In another Sorah Allah Almighty Says:

above-mentioned Quranic facts explained that from Adam (peace be upon him) to the time of last Prophet (peace be upon him) as many prophets were sent and many heavenly books were revealed, they all had the same message that there is no god but Allah. However, after modern research with various evidences, it became clear that religion is neither an evolutionary theory nor a product of human conditions, rather it is a precious gift given to human beings by Allah Ta'ala, which is given to humans from the moment they are born. It is with us and will be with us until we die. That is, the first religion in the world was monotheism, whose followers were called Muslims, but when people adopted polytheism, Allah sent prophets in every nation to correct them. Sent.

#### **Role of Religion in Human Society:**

Man's relationship with religion is very deep. So far, countless religions have come into being in the world, some of which are still present in the world in one form or another. Some names and fancies are found in the pages of history. Evidences of some religions have been found in archeology and destroyed ruins and buildings of places of worship of past nations. It became clear that every nation has some religion. <sup>8</sup>

It seems that ever since man came into this world, he must have been associated with some religion because religion is the basic need of man. Without which living is not only difficult but impossible. This is the

reason why man always seems to think that what is man? Where did it come from? Different types of birds, water, fire, wind, soil, trees, stones, mountains, rivers, rain, lightning and its thunder, birth, life, death and night, day, all these were created for whom? And which entity is running this whole system all the time? Man has come to the fact that there must be some entity above all humans who is running the system of this universe in a good way.<sup>9</sup>

## **Concept of Life Theory:**

This theory of life about the universe and the creator of the universe has been given to man by religion. Religion made man aware of his place and rank in this universe, then clarified his relationship with this universe and the creator of the universe, and then made him aware of the purpose of life.

When it is said that Allah is our supporter and supporter, it creates confidence in a person and he feels an unseen power in himself. This experience has been described in different ways in different religious traditions. In the worldly life, a person suffers from various problems and troubles step by step, a person feels his loneliness and helplessness when he is faced with a major tragedy in life, in such a situation, religion becomes a ray of light. Thanks to which the strength to face the sufferings and pains that occur in life is created in a person. Religion defends it in moments of despair and hopelessness. As it appears in the Holy Qur'an:

Syed Qutab Writes in the explanation of this verse:

## **Concept of Hope:**

Therefore, Imad-ul-Hasan, pointing to this aspect of free religion, writes that:

A box of religion or an aspect of it is related to the inner life of the individual where he is exposed to the reality of religion as a feeling and an inner event. This is the world where religion is exposed in its true reality and a direct relationship of religion is established with men. Therefore, this is the level where religion quenches man's religious thirst by coming to inner experience. <sup>15</sup>

From the above arguments, it is known that a religious man maintains his trust in his Creator and Lord in every situation and never gets frustrated by fearing the difficulties of life. He feels himself under the protection of his Lord and sometimes He does not try to commit suicide. #### **Formation of Human Civilization:**

Religion is not only a means of worshiping God and satisfying the soul, but it is the great inner force of human consciousness through which collectivity and spiritual connections are established in the society. In terms of civilization, the status of religion is very important in society because religion is closely related to human feelings. Under religion, man determines the principles and laws for society through which civilization sets its evolutionary goals. Gets organized and stable existence. Professor Khurshid Ahmed writes in:

There are two basic needs of man in the world. On the one hand, material resources are needed to maintain the relationship between body and soul, and on the other hand, moral and cultural principles are needed to keep individual and collective life on a healthy basis. He has fulfilled these two needs of man. For the satisfaction of material and human needs, he deposited an endless amount of resources in the earth and sky. He sent the Prophets for the moral and

cultural needs, who taught man the way to live. This path is called religion<sup>17</sup>-

neighbour. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.<sup>20</sup>

Therefore, according to the ideas of Sheikh Ahmad Deedat (1918-2005), truth, honesty, self-control. reconciliation, politeness. conscientiousness, agreement and other good qualities have been appreciated by all religions and vice versa cruelty, miserliness, bitterness, treachery, backbiting, backbiting and all other evils are considered bad, that is, these moral values are the common heritage of all religions.<sup>21</sup>
